- **2 Samuel 7:28** And now, O Lord GOD, you are God, and your words are true, and you have promised this good thing to your servant.
- **2 Samuel 22:31** This God--his way is perfect; the word of the LORD proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.
- 1 Kings 17:24 And the woman said to Elijah, "Now I know that you are a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in your mouth is truth."
- **Nehemiah 9:13** You came down on Mount Sinai and spoke with them from heaven and gave them right rules and true laws, good statutes and commandments,
- **Psalm 18:30** This God--his way is perfect; the word of the LORD proves true; he is a shield for all those who take refuge in him.
- **Psalm 19:9** the fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; the rules of the LORD are true, and righteous altogether.
- **Psalm 25:5** Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the day long.
- **Psalm 43:3** Send out your light and your truth; let them lead me; let them bring me to your holy hill and to your dwelling!
- **Psalm 51:6** Behold, you delight in truth in the inward being, and you teach me wisdom in the secret heart.
- **Psalm 86:11** Teach me your way, O LORD, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.
- **Psalm 119:43** And take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth, for my hope is in your rules.
- **Psalm 119:142** Your righteousness is righteous forever, and your law is true.
- Psalm 119:151 But you are near, O LORD, and all your commandments are true.
- **Psalm 119:160** The sum of your word is truth, and every one of your righteous rules endures forever.
- **Proverbs 30:5** Every word of God proves true; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him.
- **Isaiah 45:19** I did not speak in secret, in a land of darkness; I did not say to the offspring of Jacob, 'Seek me in vain.' I the LORD speak the truth; I declare what is right.
- **Isaiah 65:16** So that he who blesses himself in the land shall bless himself by the God of truth, and he who takes an oath in the land shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten and are hidden from my eyes.
- **Jeremiah 10:10** But the LORD is the true God; he is the living God and the everlasting King. At his wrath the earth quakes, and the nations cannot endure his indignation.
- **Daniel 9:13** As it is written in the Law of Moses, all this calamity has come upon us; yet we have not entreated the favor of the LORD our God, turning from our iniquities and gaining insight by your truth.
- **Matthew 5:18** For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished.
- **Matthew 5:26** Truly, I say to you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny.
- **Matthew 6:2** "Thus, when you give to the needy, sound no trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may be praised by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward.

- **Matthew 6:5** "And when you pray, you must not be like the hypocrites. For they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, that they may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward.
- Matthew 6:16 "And when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward.
- **Matthew 8:10** When Jesus heard this, he marveled and said to those who followed him, "Truly, I tell you, with no one in Israel have I found such faith.
- **Matthew 10:15** Truly, I say to you, it will be more bearable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah than for that town.
- **Matthew 10:23** When they persecute you in one town, flee to the next, for truly, I say to you, you will not have gone through all the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes.
- Matthew 10:42 (Mark 9:41) And whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward."
- **Matthew 11:11** Truly, I say to you, among those born of women there has arisen no one greater than John the Baptist. Yet the one who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- Matthew 13:17 For truly, I say to you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it.
- Matthew 16:28 (Mark 9:1) Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom."
- **Matthew 17:20** He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith like a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for you."
- **Matthew 18:3** and said, "Truly, I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.
- **Matthew 18:13** And if he finds it, truly, I say to you, he rejoices over it more than over the ninety-nine that never went astray.
- **Matthew 18:18** Truly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- **Matthew 19:23** And Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly, I say to you, only with difficulty will a rich person enter the kingdom of heaven.
- **Matthew 19:28** Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, in the new world, when the Son of Man will sit on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Matthew 21:21 (Mark 11:23) And Jesus answered them, "Truly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be taken up and thrown into the sea,' it will happen.
- Matthew 21:31 Which of the two did the will of his father?" They said, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Truly, I say to you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes go into the kingdom of God before you.
- Matthew 23:36 Truly, I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation.

- Matthew 24:2 But he answered them, "You see all these, do you not? Truly, I say to you, there will not be left here one stone upon another that will not be thrown down."
- Matthew 24:34 (Mark 13:30, Luke 21:32) Truly, I say to you, this generation will not pass away until all these things take place.
- Matthew 24:47 Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions.
- Matthew 26:13 (Mark 14:9) Truly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will also be told in memory of her."
- Matthew 26:21 (Mark 14:18) And as they were eating, he said, "Truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me."
- Matthew 26:34 (Mark 14:30) Jesus said to him, "Truly, I tell you, this very night, before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times."
- Matthew 27:54 (Mark 15:39) When the centurion and those who were with him, keeping watch over Jesus, saw the earthquake and what took place, they were filled with awe and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"
- Mark 8:12 And he sighed deeply in his spirit and said, "Why does this generation seek a sign? Truly, I say to you, no sign will be given to this generation."
- Mark 10:15 (Luke 18:17) Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it."
- Mark 10:29 (Luke 18:29) Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel,
- Mark 12:14 And they came and said to him, "Teacher, we know that you are true and do not care about anyone's opinion. For you are not swayed by appearances, but truly teach the way of God. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not? Should we pay them, or should we not?"
- Mark 12:43 (Luke 21:3) And he called his disciples to him and said to them, "Truly, I say to you, this poor widow has put in more than all those who are contributing to the offering box.
- Mark 14:25 Truly, I say to you, I will not drink again of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."
- **Luke 4:24-25** And he said, "Truly, I say to you, no prophet is acceptable in his hometown. But in truth, I tell you, there were many widows in Israel in the days of Elijah, when the heavens were shut up three years and six months, and a great famine came over all the land.
- **Luke 9:27** But I tell you truly, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the kingdom of God."
- Luke 12:37 Blessed are those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. Truly, I say to you, he will dress himself for service and have them recline at table, and he will come and serve them.
- Luke 12:44 Truly, I say to you, he will set him over all his possessions.
- **Luke 23:43** And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."
- **John 1:9** The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.
- **John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.
- **John 1:17** For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

- **John 1:51** And he said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."
- John 3:3-5 Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." Nicodemus said to him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.
- **John 3:11** Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak of what we know, and bear witness to what we have seen, but you do not receive our testimony.
- **John 3:21** But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God."
- **John 3:33** Whoever receives his testimony sets his seal to this, that God is true.
- **John 4:23-24** But the hour is coming, and is now here, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him. God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth."
- **John 5:19** So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise.
- **John 5:24-25** Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life. "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming, and is now here, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.
- **John 5:31-33** If I alone bear witness about myself, my testimony is not deemed true. There is another who bears witness about me, and I know that the testimony that he bears about me is true. You sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth.
- **John 6:26** Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate your fill of the loaves.
- **John 6:32** Jesus then said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven, but my Father gives you the true bread from heaven.
- John 6:47 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.
- **John 6:53** So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you.
- **John 7:18** The one who speaks on his own authority seeks his own glory; but the one who seeks the glory of him who sent him is true, and in him there is no falsehood.
- **John 7:28** So Jesus proclaimed, as he taught in the temple, "You know me, and you know where I come from? But I have not come of my own accord. He who sent me is true, and him you do not know.
- John 8:13-18 So the Pharisees said to him, "You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true." Jesus answered, "Even if I do bear witness about myself, my testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going, but you do not know where I come from or where I am going. You judge according to the flesh; I judge no one. Yet even if I do judge, my judgment is true, for it is not I alone who judge, but I and the Father who sent me. In your Law it is written that the testimony of two people is true.
- **John 8:26** I have much to say about you and much to judge, but he who sent me is true, and I declare to the world what I have heard from him."

- **John 8:31-32** So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
- **John 8:34** Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is a slave to sin.
- **John 8:40** but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did.
- John 8:44-46 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and has nothing to do with the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. But because I tell the truth, you do not believe me. Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, why do you not believe me?
- John 8:51 Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death."
- John 8:58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am."
- **John 10:1** "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber.
- John 10:7 So Jesus again said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.
- **John 12:24** Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies. it remains alone; but if it dies. it bears much fruit.
- **John 13:16** Truly, truly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him.
- **John 13:20-21** Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever receives the one I send receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me." After saying these things, Jesus was troubled in his spirit, and testified, "Truly, truly, I say to you, one of you will betray me."
- **John 13:38** Jesus answered, "Will you lay down your life for me? Truly, truly, I say to you, the rooster will not crow till you have denied me three times.
- **John 14:6** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.
- **John 14:12** "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.
- **John 14:17** even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.
- **John 15:26** "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.
- **John 16:13** When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.
- **John 16:20** Truly, truly, I say to you, you will weep and lament, but the world will rejoice. You will be sorrowful, but your sorrow will turn into joy.
- **John 16:23** In that day you will ask nothing of me. Truly, truly, I say to you, whatever you ask of the Father in my name, he will give it to you.
- **John 17:3** And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.
- **John 17:8** For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me.

- **John 17:17-19** Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.
- John 18:37-38 Then Pilate said to him, "So you are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say that I am a king. For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come into the world--to bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth listens to my voice." Pilate said to him, "What is truth?" After he had said this, he went back outside to the Jews and told them, "I find no guilt in him.
- **John 19:35** He who saw it has borne witness--his testimony is true, and he knows that he is telling the truth--that you also may believe.
- John 21:18 Truly, truly, I say to you, when you were young, you used to dress yourself and walk wherever you wanted, but when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go."
- **John 21:24** This is the disciple who is bearing witness about these things, and who has written these things, and we know that his testimony is true.
- Acts 26:25 But Paul said, "I am not out of my mind, most excellent Festus, but I am speaking true and rational words.
- **Romans 1:18** For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.
- **Romans 1:25** because they exchanged the truth about God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.
- **Romans 2:8** but for those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.
- Romans 3:4 By no means! Let God be true though every one were a liar, as it is written, "That you may be justified in your words, and prevail when you are judged."
- **Romans 15:8** For I tell you that Christ became a servant to the circumcised to show God's truthfulness, in order to confirm the promises given to the patriarchs.
- **1 Corinthians 13:6** it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth.
- 2 Corinthians 4:2 But we have renounced disgraceful, underhanded ways. We refuse to practice cunning or to tamper with God's word, but by the open statement of the truth we would commend ourselves to everyone's conscience in the sight of God.
- **2 Corinthians 6:7-8** [We commend ourselves in every way . . .] by truthful speech, and the power of God; with the weapons of righteousness for the right hand and for the left; through honor and dishonor, through slander and praise. We are treated as impostors, and yet are true;
- ${\bf 2} \ {\bf Corinthians} \ {\bf 13:8} \ {\bf For} \ {\bf we} \ {\bf cannot} \ {\bf do} \ {\bf anything} \ {\bf against} \ {\bf the} \ {\bf truth}, \ {\bf but} \ {\bf only} \ {\bf for} \ {\bf the} \ {\bf truth}.$
- **Galatians 2:5** to them we did not yield in submission even for a moment, so that the truth of the gospel might be preserved for you.
- **Galatians 2:14** But when I saw that their conduct was not in step with the truth of the gospel, I said to Cephas before them all, "If you, though a Jew, live like a Gentile and not like a Jew, how can you force the Gentiles to live like Jews?"
- **Galatians 4:16** Have I then become your enemy by telling you the truth?
- **Galatians 5:7** You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the truth?
- **Ephesians 1:13** In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,
- **Ephesians 4:15** Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ,
- **Ephesians 4:21** assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus,

- **Ephesians 4:25** Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members one of another.
- **Ephesians 6:14** Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness,
- **Philippians 4:8** Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.
- Colossians 1:5-6 because of the hope laid up for you in heaven. Of this you have heard before in the word of the truth, the gospel, which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and growing--as it also does among you, since the day you heard it and understood the grace of God in truth,
- 2 Thessalonians 2:9-15 The coming of the lawless one is by the activity of Satan with all power and false signs and wonders, and with all wicked deception for those who are perishing, because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. Therefore God sends them a strong delusion, so that they may believe what is false, in order that all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness. But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth. To this he called you through our gospel, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. So then, brothers, stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter.
- 1 Timothy 2:4 who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth
- **1 Timothy 2:7** For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.
- **1 Timothy 3:15** if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth.
- **1 Timothy 4:3** who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods that God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.
- **1 Timothy 6:5** and constant friction among people who are deprayed in mind and deprived of the truth, imagining that godliness is a means of gain.
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.
- **2 Timothy 2:18** who have swerved from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already happened. They are upsetting the faith of some.
- **2 Timothy 2:25** correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth,
- **2 Timothy 3:7-8** always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth. Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith.
- 2 Timothy 4:2-5 preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths. As for you, always be soberminded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.
- **Titus 1:1** Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth, which accords with godliness,

- **Titus 1:14** not devoting themselves to Jewish myths and the commands of people who turn away from the truth.
- **Hebrews 10:26** For if we go on sinning deliberately after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,
- **James 1:18** Of his own will he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.
- **James 3:14** But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth.
- **James 5:19** My brothers, if anyone among you wanders from the truth and someone brings him back,
- **1 Peter 1:22** Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,
- 1 Peter 5:12 By Silvanus, a faithful brother as I regard him, I have written briefly to you, exhorting and declaring that this is the true grace of God. Stand firm in it.
- 2 Peter 1:12 Therefore I intend always to remind you of these qualities, though you know them and are established in the truth that you have.
- 2 Peter 2:2 And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed.
- 1 John 1:6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.
- 1 John 1:8 If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 1 John 2:4-5a Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected.
- 1 John 2:8 At the same time, it is a new commandment that I am writing to you, which is true in him and in you, because the darkness is passing away and the true light is already shining.
- 1 John 2:21-22 I write to you, not because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and because no lie is of the truth. Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son.
- 1 John 2:27 But the anointing that you received from him abides in you, and you have no need that anyone should teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie--just as it has taught you, abide in him.
- **1 John 3:18-19** Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth. By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him:
- **1 John 4:6** We are from God. Whoever knows God listens to us; whoever is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the Spirit of truth and the spirit of error.
- **1 John 5:6** This is he who came by water and blood--Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the Spirit is the one who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth.
- **1 John 5:20** And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us understanding, so that we may know him who is true; and we are in him who is true, in his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God and eternal life.
- 2 John 1-4 The elder to the elect lady and her children, whom I love in truth, and not only I, but also all who know the truth, because of the truth that abides in us and will be with us forever: Grace, mercy, and peace will be with us, from God the Father and from Jesus Christ the Father's Son, in truth and love. I rejoiced greatly to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as we were commanded by the Father.

- **3 John 1-4** The elder to the beloved Gaius, whom I love in truth. Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul. For I rejoiced greatly when the brothers came and testified to your truth, as indeed you are walking in the truth. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.
- 3 John 8 Therefore we ought to support people like these, that we may be fellow workers for the truth.
- **3 John 12** Demetrius has received a good testimony from everyone, and from the truth itself. We also add our testimony, and you know that our testimony is true.
- **Revelation 3:7** "And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: 'The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens.
- **Revelation 3:14** "And to the angel of the church in Laodicea write: 'The words of the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's creation.
- **Revelation 6:10** They cried out with a loud voice, "O Sovereign Lord, holy and true, how long before you will judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"
- **Revelation 15:3** And they sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, "Great and amazing are your deeds, O Lord God the Almighty! Just and true are your ways, O King of the nations!
- **Revelation 16:7** And I heard the altar saying, "Yes, Lord God the Almighty, true and just are your judgments!"
- **Revelation 19:2** for his judgments are true and just; for he has judged the great prostitute who corrupted the earth with her immorality, and has avenged on her the blood of his servants."
- Revelation 19:9 And the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he said to me, "These are the true words of God."
- **Revelation 19:11** Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war
- **Revelation 21:5** And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." Also he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."
- **Revelation 22:6** And he said to me, "These words are trustworthy and true. And the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent his angel to show his servants what must soon take place."
